## SAT PREPARATION

**6 Sessions Total: Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays – March 31, April 2, 4, 7, 9, and 11.**

The **SAT Exam** will be given on **May 2, 2009**. Check with your High School Guidance Office as to time and location.

### Why is the SAT so important?

The SAT measures verbal and mathematical reasoning abilities and these test scores are used to assist colleges in evaluating applicants. Many times, these scores are the determining factor in deciding admissions.

### How will this course help my student?

Enrollment in this program will help students:

- Sharpen critical reading, vocabulary/grammar skills, sentence completion and composition.
- Review algebra, geometry, and word problems.
- Deal with test-taking anxieties and suggest test taking and problem solving strategies.
- Explore the "new" changes in the SAT: critical reading, grammar and usage, a student-written essay, third year math, etc.

### When and where will the SAT Preparation course be offered?

The course will be held on the campus of Appalachian State University in Walker Hall, Room 106.
