Packing

Although it's only a weekend, there are a few things you'll need that you might not normally pack for a weekend trip.

What to Bring

- Bed Linens – twin sheets, pillowcase, pillow, blanket **or** a sleeping bag & pillow. You will be housed in a cabin with bunkbeds and heat. There are bathrooms and showers in each cabin.
- Comfortable clothes and shoes. Jeans are fine for classes. Make sure to wear shoes that are suitable for walking.
- Towels and toiletries such as soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Notebook, pencils, pens, and any other supplies listed in your course description.
- Spending money for snacks, souvenirs, etc. All meals and other living expenses are covered by the program fee. \$15 - \$20 is more than enough money unless you're buying lots of souvenirs! We cannot cash personal checks, so please bring cash only.

What Not to Bring

- A car, motorcycle, bicycle, or other moving vehicle. You may drive here yourself, but once here you will not be able to use your car or other vehicle.
- Medication, drugs, or pills, unless listed on the Medical Release Form with an explanation of the purpose of the medication.
- Alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs. **Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the program.**
- Cigarettes, other tobacco products, matches, lighters, or candles. **Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the program.**
- Knives or other weapons. Persons in possession of weapons will be subject to prosecution by State Law Chapter 558 (H1008) General Section 14-269.2. **Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the program.**
