### Rules and Regulations

As a guest of the University, you are expected to adhere to high standards of conduct both on and off campus and at Camp Broadstone. You must accept responsibility for your conduct and behavior at all times. This includes: being honest, truthful, fair, civil, and concerned for others inside and outside the classroom. The campus, classrooms, Camp Broadstone and other facilities, including equipment, should be used respectfully and kept clean at all times. Any violation, as stated below, can result in disciplinary action and /or dismissal from the program.

#### Rules and Regulations

- All students must respect and follow the direction of their Resident Counselor.
- No alcohol and/or illegal drugs. **Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the program.**
- Any use of tobacco products is prohibited. **Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the program.**
- No weapons of any kind. Persons in possession of weapons will be subject to prosecution by State Law Chapter 558 (H1008) General Section 14-269.2. **Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the program.**
- Use of electronic devices is at the discretion of the instructor or the Resident Counselor.
- No pets of any kind are allowed.
- Scholars are not allowed to leave Camp for any reason.
- Cabin raids are strictly prohibited. Boys are not allowed in the girls cabins and girls are not allowed in the boys cabins.
- All Scholars must be in their designated cabin at 10:30 pm and in bed with lights out at 11 pm.
- Everyone is to obey the rules and regulations that govern Appalachian State University.
- Scholars must be respectful to and follow directions of their instructors and any other ASU staff.
- Scholars must stay with the class group, stay in designated areas and not leave the group while on campus. This includes during meal time and walking across camp and campus.
